

Hotels, like all businesses and all citizens, must not be allowed to jam cellular or WiFi signals. Such jamming poses a great threat to public safety, leaving patrons and passers by unable to contact emergency personnel or families and loved ones.

Jamming of the public airwaves, including unlicensed spectrum, is illegal for good reasons, and anyone who does it should face severe punishment. Private parties are not entitled to do so for financial gain or for any other reason.

The FCC must not allow greedy hotel chains to subject their residents and visitors to the possible loss of urgent communications and to the extra cost of paying the hotel for access to the public spectrum.
