Pursuant to the Public Notice, dated December 18, 2014, DA-14-839, Last Mile Broadband LLC ("Last Mile" or "the Company", by and through its undersigned counsel, do hereby notify the FCC that it wishes to remain in consideration for rural broadband experiments support.

The Company recently noticed that it was included in Attachment A to the referenced Public Notice. However, Last Mile believes that its inclusion was an inadvertent error as it was provisionally selected for funding. Indeed, the Company also appeared on the Commission's December 23, 2014 Public Notice, DA 14-1889, as a provisional awardee that filed a Request for Waiver, which is accurate.

Today, Last Mile filed its Reply Comments in Opposition to the Comments filed against its Request for Waiver, a copy of which is attached. It also should be noted that Last Mile is re-filing its network design that has been P.E.-certified via the Commission's auction website (FCC Form 5620).
