Re: Proceeding RM-11737

In filing this petition Marriott asks for authorization to interfere with all kinds of signals and transmissions in the 2.4GHz band which just by chance are anywhere near one of Marriott's properties. Since it has not been shown anywhere in the petition that Marriott would be able to determine between unregulated Part 15 transmissions and regulated Part 97 transmissions.

I will not go into the legality of interfering with Part 15 transmissions, even though my opinion is that nobody should be able to interfere with anybody else's transmission just because they do not like it or for commercial gain (which in all reality this is about). In addition if this petition would be granted this would basically be the equivalent of granting Marriott an exclusive license in the 2.4GHz band wherever Marriott decides to or acquire a property regardless of the rights of other equally entitled users.

Another reason to decline this petition is that Marriotts jammers would severely interfere with a growing number of devices enabling the disabled, of which a fair and growing percentage utilize the license free 2.4GHz spectrum.

For the reasons mentioned above and for the legal reasons many others have already brought before this commission this petition should be DENIED.
