Subject: Good Faith Complaint pursuant to FCC Section 76.65

Dear FCC:

We hereby file this complaint pursuant to section 76.65 against Nexstar the licensee of KTVX, KUCW in Salt Lake City, Utah, the affiliates of ABC and CW respectively.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

We received a proposal from management of KTVX and KUCW on December 17, 2014 the proposal contained prices and terms. There was only a single proposal provided by Nexstar. Prior to this proposal we did not receive any documents from Nexstar.

We reviewed the contract language and provided our objections. We came to an agreement on the language. Thereafter we discussed the retransmission consent fees. We did not accept the retransmission fee offer, we made counter proposal. See Exhibit A. Copy of retransmission consent agreement and email from Nexstar.

Thereafter, we agreed to the price for the ABC affiliate, however, the management of KTVX informed us that if we don't carry their second station, CW, we will not be allowed to carry KTVX. "No Tariq, I have explicitly explained the process ... this is not a smorgasbord. There is no ABC4 without CW30, and no CW30 without ABC4. See Exhibit B.

We made an offer to carry CW, however rather than responding to our offer, Nexstar refused our offer and told us to remove their stations by December 31, 2014

We contacted KTVX by email, see record attached herewith that we will contact them on Monday and negotiate further, however the management of KTVX sent an email stating, there is no need to talk as they will not change their position. "Tariq, based on your very offensive response to me on Friday night, I don't see how any further verbal discussions will help further our cause since you have devalued all the positive interaction, rate reductions, compromises in contract language which we made with you." See Exhibit C.

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ISSUES FOR FCC

Nexstar violated section 76.65(b)(iv) in that Nexstar only provided a single unilateral proposal for carriage.

Nexstar violated section 76.65(b)(v) Failure of Nexstar to respond to proposal sent by Satview for pricing on KUCW.

Nexstar violated section 76.65(b)(v) In that Nexstar refused to allow carriage of only ABC affiliate without also having to carry KUCW. This bundling of two independent stations violates the terms of the Good Faith Negotiations as each channel must be independent of the other.

At no time did KTVX put forth more than a single proposal as required under 76.65(iv), rather the management of KTVX offered a single proposal with a single price level.

We notified KTVX our intention to file a complaint with the FCC by telephone and email. Due to the unreasonable negotiating stance taken by KTVX we discounted carrying their channels CW and KTVX on our systems effective December 31, 2014.


RELIEF REQUESTED

We request the following relief:

1. Order KTVX to unbundle the negotiations for the two stations ABC and CW from Salt Lake City;
2. Review KTVX and its management activities regarding violating the section 76.65;
3. Order KTVX to permit Satview to carry KTVX while the negotiations are containing.
4. Award Satview for all damages suffered due to the conduct of KTVX and its management.
5. Fine KTVX and its management the statutory maximum for violations of the FCC regulations.
6. For any other relief the FCC made deem just and proper.
