
Dear Ms. Dortch:

On separate occasions, several FCC Commissioners and/or their staffs participated in demonstrations of NextNav's indoor location technology, which were held at Tysons Corner Center, located at 1961 Chain Bridge Rd, McLean, VA 22102. On Monday, January 12, 2015, participants included Commissioner Ajit Pai, his Chief of Staff, Matthew Berry, his legal advisors, Brendan Carr and Nicholas Degani, and intern, Christopher Mills. On the morning of Wednesday, January 14, 2015, participants included Priscilla Delgado Argeris, legal advisor to Commissioner Jessica Rosenworcel. On the afternoon of Wednesday, January 14, 2015, participants included Commissioner Michael O'Rielly, his Chief of Staff, Robin Colwell, and his legal advisors, Erin McGrath and Amy Bender.

Escorting the Commission officials during the demonstrations were Gary Parsons, CEO of NextNav; Ganesh Pattabiraman, President and Co-Founder of NextNav; and Bruce Cox, Senior Director, Regulatory & Public Safety. In addition, Rajendra Singh, Chairman of the Board for NextNav, and NextNav board member, Monish Kundra, participated in the demonstration on Monday, and Justin Lilley of TeleMedia Policy Corporation participated in the demonstrations on Wednesday.

During the demonstrations, the NextNav representatives discussed their views on the draft wireless location order that is on circulation within the Commission. The substance of these discussions is detailed in a companion *ex parte* notice that NextNav is filing on this date addressing a meeting with the staff of the Public Safety and Homeland Security Bureau.
