**Re: Quarterly Compliance Report of The Alaska Wireless Network, LLC,  
Regarding Broadband Deployment Commitments, WT Docket No.  
12-187, WC Docket No. 09-197**

Dear Ms. Dortch:

Pursuant to the Commission's July 16, 2013 *Memorandum Opinion and Order* ("AWN Order"),<sup>1</sup> The Alaska Wireless Network, LLC ("AWN"), hereby submits this Quarterly Compliance Report for the period from the Closing Date of the AWN transaction through September 30, 2014. We are pleased to inform the Commission that AWN has successfully met each of the four commitments that it made with respect to the deployment and maintenance of wireless services in Remote Alaska.

According to Paragraph 138 of the *AWN Order*, AWN's Quarterly reports to the Commission must include the following:

**(i) A statement as to the status of the Company's compliance with each of the four individual commitments.**

*AWN Response:* As of December 31, 2014, AWN complied with each of the four individual commitments. AWN continues to comply with those commitments.

**(ii) The number of POPs in Remote Alaska that are receiving LTE services in accordance with the first commitment that were not receiving LTE services prior to the Closing Date.**

*AWN Response:* As of December 31, 2014, AWN had extended LTE capability to approximately 74,000 additional POPs in Remote Alaska that were not receiving LTE services prior to July 23, 2013 (the AWN closing date).

**(iii) The additional Remote Alaska communities (including non-3G portions) that are receiving 3G services in accordance with the second commitment that were not receiving 3G services prior to the Closing Date.**

*AWN Response:* As of December 31, 2014, AWN had extended 3G services to the following eight Remote Alaska communities (including non-3G portions), which had not been receiving 3G service as of July 23, 2013. This exceeds the commitment, which was to extend 3G service to six such communities (or non-3G portions thereof).

**(iv) Identification of the additional 2G macrosites that have been or are being constructed in Remote Alaska in accordance with the third commitment.**

*AWN Response:* As of December 31, 2014, AWN had constructed and initiated services through the following 13 additional macrosites in Remote Alaska, which sites were not constructed or in operation on July 23, 2013. This exceeds the commitment, which was to construct 12 additional Remote Alaska macrosites.

*AWN Response:* As its fourth commitment, AWN agreed to maintain 2G service everywhere in Remote Alaska that it was offered as of the date of the *AWN Order*.<sup>2</sup> AWN has fulfilled this commitment by maintaining 2G service in each area throughout Remote Alaska.
