**WITHDRAWAL OF PROTEST**

The Central Station Alarm Association (“CSAA”), by its attorneys, hereby concurs with a grant of above-captioned application of Emergency Radio Service, Inc. (“ERS”), as amended on January 14, 2015; and on the basis of that amendment, CSAA withdraws its September 29, 2014 request that the above-captioned application be dismissed or denied. This application requested authority for ERS to construct and operate a five channel centralized trunking system utilizing the frequencies 460/465.900, 460/465.925, 460/465.950, 460/465.975, and 461/466.000 MHz. The January 14, 2015 amendment has deleted the proposal to operate on those frequencies, such that CSAA’s concerns have been mooted.
