Beneficiary Green Dot Public Schools (GDPS) requests that the Demand Payment Letters issued by the Universal Service Administrative Company ("USAC") on December 16, 2014 (**Attachment A**) be placed on hold until there is a resolution with a pending appeal to be filed with the Commission in response to a COMAD Appeal Denial Letter issued by USAC on December 15, 2014 (**Attachment B**). The 60-day window allowed by the Commission for beneficiaries to appeal USAC decisions will elapse on Friday February 13, 2015, 28 days after the demanded payment is due.
