Petitioner failed to acknowledge that they are secondary users of at least portions of the spectrum enabling "WiFi" and thus have not disclosed how they intend to not disrupt use by licensed user of the spectrum.

While it is perfectly reasonable to manage ones own network to enhance network security, but to disrupt the activities of others is unreasonable and constitute deliberate harmful interference to other users both part 15, part 97 , and otherwise.

It would seem that petitioner would be better served by utilizing proprietary wireless networking device to ensure end to end security, if network security is their true concern
