

- December 23, 2014 – We called and were informed at this time that we had miscalculated the deadline date. When we inquired about the appeal process, we were told we could appeal although the deadline was December 18, 2014 but we could try. For 2122687, 2122639 and 2122595
- December 23, 2014 – Completed online appeal form and also faxed the form to the number provided for 2122687, 2122639 and 2122595.
- January 8, 2015 – 2122608 was declined
- January 14, 2015 – Resubmitted 212608 the number changed to 2134284
- January 14, 2015 – Auto-generated /Form 472 successfully submitted – Awaiting Certification
- January 15, 2015 – Invoice 2134284 Received notice for certification of 12 out of 12 items.



January 20, 2015 – Contacted USAC to inquire of the status of appeal. We were informed that we needed to appeal to the FCC and request that the dates be waived so that we can file and receive our reimbursement through E-Rate.
