WITHDRAWAL OF APPLICATION FOR REVIEW

The Utilities Telecom Council (“UTC”) and Winchester Cator, LLC (“Winchester”) (together, “UTC/Winchester”) hereby withdraw their Petition for Rulemaking to Establish Rules Governing Critical Infrastructure Industry Fixed Service Operations in the 14.0-14.5 GHz Band.”¹ They also hereby withdraw as moot their Application for Review of the Bureau’s decision in the above-captioned proceeding that denied UTC/Winchester’s Petition for Rulemaking (“Application for Review”).²
