On January 23, 2015, the undersigned, counsel for Breitling USA, Inc. (“Breitling”), Jean-Paul Girardin, Vice President, Breitling SA, and Thierry Prisset, President, Breitling USA, met with the following Wireless Telecommunications Bureau staff: Scot Stone, Jim Shaffer, Tom Derenge, and Jeffrey Tobias.

The participants discussed the request for waiver filed by Breitling in the above-captioned docket. In particular, Breitling emphasized the efforts it has taken to ensure the safety and reliability of the Emergency watch, and stated its confidence that grant of the waiver will not affect reliable PLB operations and may save lives without incurring significant disadvantage. Breitling additionally noted that the immediate access to a PLB that the wrist-worn PLB provides offsets any minimal technical limitations that may exist.

The attached handout was provided, and includes a revised “Conditions of Use” that Breitling suggests should be used for U.S. customers, as detailed in its reply comments.¹
