Dear Ms. Dortch:

On January 22, 2015, Robert Hunt of Guadalupe Valley Telephone Cooperative (“GVTC”) and Jon Banks and B. Lynn Follansbee of USTelecom met with Victoria Goldberg, Deena Shetler, Robin Cohn, Pamela Arluk and Greg Haledjian of the Wireline Competition Bureau and Daniel Alvarez, Counsel to Chairman Wheeler. The subject of discussion was the GVTC Petition for Limited Waiver of the Commission’s intercarrier compensation revenue recovery rules.¹

GVTC seeks in its Petition to include in FY 2011 Base Period Revenue unpaid amounts billed to Halo Wireless, Inc. (“Halo”). Given the relief granted by the Commission’s Halo Order for similar petitions, subject to certain conditions,² the GVTC representatives met to discuss with Commission staff whether any additional information could be provided to rule on the Petition. Mr. Hunt provided Commission staff with background information on GVTC and reiterated its need for a grant in this instance and requested that relief be granted to GVTC.
