Dear FCC Secretary,

One Ministries, Inc. (OMI) is in agreement with Venture's comments concerning allowing digital Channel 6s to broadcast to FM radios. The 87.7 MHz Aural services that Venture provides give an avenue to ethnic programming that is otherwise not available. We are saddened that some organizations would be against this or want to delay action by the FCC to make this happen right away for digital Channel 6 LPTV stations. We want to applaud the FCC for finally granting OMI's channel 6 applications after holding up the permits from being granted for five years. OMI currently runs a youth oriented radio station in California and would like to further its mission with its channel 6 LPTV stations and to also broadcast on 87.7 MHz. OMI's fear is that the FCC will put off addressing the need to allow digital LPTV channel 6s to also broadcast to radios on 87.7. OMI also operates class A and LPTV stations in Northern California, and we broadcast ethnic Spanish-language programming. If you look at the largest non-commercial station owner in the United States, Educational Media Foundation, they are in favor of allowing LPTV channel 6s to broadcast to radio stations on 87.7. Please solidify allowing digital channel 6s to broadcast to FM radios on 87.7 right away.
