JOINT MOTION TO HOLD PLEADING CYCLE IN ABEYANCE

DIRECTV, LLC (“DIRECTV”) and KSQA, LLC, licensee of KSQA (TV), Topeka, KS (“KSQA”) hereby request the Commission hold the comment cycle in the above-captioned proceeding in abeyance pending final resolution of ongoing settlement discussions.¹ KSQA has filed a must-carry complaint against DIRECTV, and the parties are engaged in settlement discussions seeking to reach an agreement under which DIRECTV will carry KSQA.

Accordingly, the parties request that the Commission hold the comment cycle in this proceeding in abeyance while the parties seek to finalize these arrangements and DIRECTV commences carrying KSQA. The parties will notify the Commission when that occurs, at which point they will request that the Commission dismiss the above-captioned complaint as moot. In the very unlikely event that the parties are unable to fully resolve their dispute, they will also so notify the Commission in writing, and request that DIRECTV be given twenty days from such notification to respond to KSQA’s complaint.
