Dear Ms. Dortch:

On January 30, 2015, Reed Hundt, representing the technology company Adaptive Spectrum and Signal Alignment, Inc. (ASSIA), met with Jon Wilkins, Managing Director of the Commission, to discuss the utility of ASSIA's Internet diagnostic and optimization application, Cloudcheck, in enforcing the Commission's forthcoming open Internet rules. Reference was made to the *ex parte* letter ASSIA filed with the Commission on January 28, 2015. The parties discussed how the Commission would have trouble enforcing its forthcoming rules in every individual consumer's home and why the Commission would therefore benefit from finding methods to empower consumers to enforce the rules themselves with easy-to-use and free applications such as Cloudcheck. Mr. Hundt reiterated that Cloudcheck is the kind of application the Commission could suggest, in the forthcoming open Internet order or during the discussion of the item at the upcoming February 26, 2015 open meeting, as a useful tool consumers can use to ensure compliance with the forthcoming ruling.
