

1987, in the County of St. Charles, State of Missouri, the defendant had deviate sexual intercourse with C.Z., to whom defendant was not married and who was then fourteen or fifteen years old.


MEMORANDUM

Comes now the State of Missouri by and through assistant prosecuting attorney Rebecca Shaffar and the Defendant by and through his attorney Wayne T. Schoeneberg. The State and the Defendant announce ready for trial, the defendant having entered a plea of not guilty to Counts I through XII of the Second Amended Information filed herein. The parties agree that if certain witnesses were called to testify in this case their testimony would be as set forth herein. The defendant specifically does not admit that any of the testimony is true or that any of the acts took place. The expected testimony is set out herein by Count and said Counts are in reference to the Counts as set forth in the Second Amended Information filed by the State in this case. The State and Defendant submit this cause to the Court with the following being a stipulation as to what the testimony would be:

██████████ would testify as to Count I that between December of 1985 and August of 1986 in the County of St. Charles, State of Missouri, the Defendant Michael Rice put his mouth on the genitals of the said ██████████; that the Defendant and ██████████ were not married and that the said ██████████ was then fourteen or fifteen years old. The defendant knew or was aware that the victim was under the age of 16.

COUNT II

██████████ would testify as to Count II that between August of 1986 and August 11, 1987 in the County of St. Charles, State of Missouri, the Defendant Michael Rice put his mouth on the genitals of the said ██████████; that the Defendant and ██████████ were not married and that the said ██████████ was then fourteen or fifteen years old. The defendant knew or was aware that the victim was under the age of 16.

The defendant knew or was aware that the victim was under the age of 17.

COUNT IV

[REDACTED] would testify as to Count IV that during October, 1988 in the County of St. Charles, State of Missouri, the Defendant Michael Rice put his mouth on the genitals of the said [REDACTED] and the defendant and [REDACTED] were not married and the said [REDACTED] was then less than fourteen years old.

COUNT V

[REDACTED] would testify as to Count V that during October, 1988 in the County of St. Charles, State of Missouri, the Defendant Michael Rice put his mouth on the genitals of the said [REDACTED] and that the Defendant and [REDACTED] were not married and the said [REDACTED] was then less than fourteen years old, and this act occurred about one hour after the act in Count IV.


That these sexual acts in Counts I through XII were done for the purpose of arousing or gratifying the sexual desire of any person.

That the act of the defendant placing his mouth on the genitals of the above victims as designated in Counts I through XI constitutes deviate sexual intercourse. That the act of the defendant placing his hand on the victim's genitals as designated in Count XII constitutes deviate sexual intercourse.

That the defendant's date of birth is June 30, 1941.

That being all of the evidence, the State rests. The Defendant, by this document makes his Motion for Judgment of Acquittal at the close of the State's evidence, offers no evidence and makes a Motion for Judgment of Acquittal at the close of all the evidence. The matter is hereby submitted to the Court for its decision.


566.070. Deviate sexual assault in the first degree

1. A person commits the crime of deviate sexual assault in the first degree if he has deviate sexual intercourse with another person to whom he is not married and who is incapacitated or who is fourteen or fifteen years old.
2. Deviate sexual assault in the first degree is a class C felony unless in the course thereof the actor inflicts serious physical injury on any person or displays a deadly weapon in a threatening manner, in which cases the crime is a class B felony.

566.080. Deviate sexual assault in the second degree

1. A person commits the crime of deviate sexual assault in the second degree if, being seventeen years old or more, he has deviate sexual intercourse with another person to whom he is not married who is sixteen years old.
2. Deviate sexual assault in the second degree is a class D felony unless in the course thereof the actor inflicts serious physical injury on any person or displays a deadly weapon in a threatening manner, in which cases the crime is a class C felony.

SEXUAL OFFENSES

566.060. Sodomy.

1. A person commits the crime of sodomy if he has deviate sexual intercourse with another person without that person's consent by the use of forcible compulsion.
2. Forcible sodomy or an attempt to commit forcible sodomy as described in subsection 1 of this section or sodomy as described in subsection 3 of this section is a felony for which the authorized term of imprisonment, including both prison and conditional terms, is life imprisonment or a term of years not less than five years, unless in the course thereof the actor inflicts serious physical injury on any person, displays a deadly weapon or dangerous instrument in a threatening manner or subjects the victim to deviate sexual intercourse or sexual intercourse with more than one person, in which cases forcible sodomy or an attempt to commit forcible sodomy is a class A felony.
3. A person commits the crime of sodomy if he has deviate sexual intercourse with another person to whom he is not married who is less than fourteen years old.





The Revised Statutes of Missouri, **Chapter 589** Sections 400 to 425 and **43.650**, RSMo., mandate that the Missouri State Highway Patrol shall maintain a sex offender database and a web site on the Internet that is accessible to the public. Additional information and verification may be obtained from the Chief Law Enforcement Official (Sheriff) of the county where the sex offender resides. The web site is intended to supplement and complement the sex offender registries maintained by the various counties.

The information on the web site refers only to persons who have been convicted of, found guilty of or plead guilty to committing or attempting to commit sexual offenses and may not reflect the entire criminal history of a particular individual. Offenders required to register for crimes of kidnapping, felonious restraint or child abuse may not be listed on this web site.

The Sex Offender Registry was created in response to the Missouri Legislature's resolution to facilitate public access to available information about persons registered as sexual offenders. The Missouri State Highway Patrol, Criminal Justice Information Services (CJIS) Division, has not considered or assessed the specific risk of re-offense with regard to any individual prior to his or her inclusion on this web site and has made no determination that any individual included on the web site is currently dangerous. Individuals included on the web site are included solely by virtue of their conviction record and Missouri state law. The primary purpose of providing this information is to make the information easily available and accessible, not to warn about any specific individual.

It should be noted that maps of offenders may not show all offenders in a given area. This is because home, work, school, and temporary address information may not be adequate to map.

These records are updated daily in an effort to assure that the information on the web site is complete and accurate; however, the Patrol makes no representation, express or implied, that the information contained on the web site is accurate.

The information available via the toll-free telephone number shall include only information that offenders are required to provide under section 589.407, RSMo. When the highway patrol provides such information

regarding a sexual offender, the patrol personnel shall advise the person making the inquiry that positive identification of a person believed to be a sexual offender cannot be established unless a fingerprint comparison is made, and that it is illegal to use such information regarding a registered sexual offender to facilitate the commission of a crime. The toll-free telephone number shall be published on the highway patrol's sexual offender registry web site maintained under section 43.650.

The information contained on the web site can change at any time, so the current residence, status or other information regarding an offender may not be accurate. Though much of the information is of record, some information is gathered from the offenders themselves who may fail to provide accurate or required information. Additional information and verification can be obtained from the Chief Law Enforcement Official (Sheriff) of the county where the sex offender resides.

An EXEMPT offender is one who had previously been required to register, but no longer has a "duty" as a result of the 2006/2007 Missouri Supreme court rulings dealing with retroactive application of the law. (See fact sheet page). If you have seen an offender in the past who is no longer listed, it may be due to their conviction, plea, or adjudication date being prior to the date the offense was added to the Missouri sex offender statutes.

Due to a Ruling of the Missouri Court of Appeals Western District (WD68066), the exempt list will no longer be posted on our web site.


