Attached please find Charter Communications, Inc.'s ("Charter") response to the letter dated January 15, 2015 from William Lake, Chief of the Media Bureau, and the accompanying Information and Data Request to Charter Communications, Inc. ("Second Information Request" or "RFI") issued by the Federal Communications Commission ("Commission" or "FCC") in connection with the Applications of Comcast Corporation, Time Warner Cable Inc., Charter Communications, Inc., and SpinCo for Consent to Assign Licenses or Transfer Control of Licenses.
