Dear Ms. Dortch,

On February 4, 2015, D. Zachary Champ and the undersigned of PCIA – The Wireless Infrastructure Association (“PCIA”) and Brian Josef of CTIA—The Wireless Association® (“CTIA”) (collectively, “Industry Associations”) met with Chad Breckinridge, Jeff Steinberg, and Johanna Thomas of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau (“Bureau”).

The Industry Associations provided an update to staff regarding the Industry Associations’ monthly discussions since December 2014 with representatives from the National League of Cities (“NLC”), National Association of Counties (“NACo”), National Association of Telecommunications Officers and Advisors (“NATOA”), and the United States Conference of Mayors. The goal of the parties is to produce a toolkit of materials that will help resource-constrained municipalities implement the new rules promulgated by the FCC’s Acceleration of Broadband Deployment Report and Order (“Order”)¹ that implement and define terms of Section 6409(a) of the Spectrum Act.²

As contemplated by the Order,³ the parties aim to distribute:

- A checklist to streamline review processes;
- Best practices used by jurisdictions able to review and approve applications in less than sixty days;
- Webinars and contacts for education and assistance regarding application process; and
- A model ordinance and application.

At present, the groups expects to finalize and distribute the checklist and model ordinance implementing Section 6409(a) by the end of February 2015.
