On February 5, 2015, Dean Brenner and the undersigned from QUALCOMM Incorporated (“Qualcomm”) discussed the above-referenced proceeding with Erin McGrath, legal advisor to Commissioner Michael O’Rielly, and Brendan Carr, legal advisor to Commissioner Ajit Pai.

Qualcomm explained the benefits that the new air-ground service would provide to air travelers across the U.S., providing an in-flight mobile broadband user experience that is equivalent to what is available on the ground today. Qualcomm encouraged the FCC to issue a Report and Order establishing the Next Generation Air-Ground service in the 14.0-14.5 GHz band as soon as possible.
