As an organization of dedicated public safety professionals, the California Fire Chiefs Association (CalChiefs) applauds the FCC's attention to the critically important matter of improving the delivery of accurate caller location information on indoor and outdoor wireless 9-1-1 calls in a timely manner. The FCC's Proposed Rulemaking (TFNPR) on this matter, represents much needed progress in providing emergency service providers with valuable accurate caller location information on wireless 9-1-1 calls.

The CalChiefs urges the FCC to move forward and adopt the rules, as proposed, to require the timely delivery of accurate caller location information on all wireless 9-1-1 calls, indoor and outdoor, within two years. Any delay in this ruling will adversely affect public safety and the people we serve.
