  - Applicability to Dockets 12-268 and 03-185.
2. FAB December 15, 2014 letter to Honorable Messrs. Wheeler and Sargeant
  - Written response requested.
3. Fourth FAB request, now to OCBO and to the Media Bureau, for original Greenhill outputs on modeled LPTV impacts on 132 MHz cleared.
4. Clarification awaited on not selling in the forward more than is bought in reverse or already vacant – raised in the 1<sup>st</sup> R&O Reconsideration.
5. Adverse effect on LPTV with proposed guard bands, new "remainder spectrum," 6MHz whitespace reservation, and new digital replacement translators (DRTs).
  - All are outside of 309(j) and the Spectrum Act.
6. Historic inverse condemnation claims.
7. Conclusion – Recommended documentary for FCC staff review.
  - A new 28-minute documentary airing on local DC TV on a past, U.S. Government stewardship tragedy. It raises similar themes to re-allotment of LPTV spectrum.
