Dear Ms. Dortch:

This letter supplements CenturyLink's Petition for Limited Waiver in the above-captioned proceeding. On January 29, 2015, CenturyLink requested permission to submit its data container, as well as its response to Question II.A.5 of the Special Access Data Collection, on February 17, 2015.¹ On that same date, CenturyLink filed its response to the other parts of the data collection.

In the Petition, CenturyLink noted its difficulty in identifying the in-service date of the Nodes it will identify in response to Question II.A.5. As subsequently discussed with Commission staff, CenturyLink has now found additional sources of data for the in-service dates, but additional work is necessary to correlate the data sources to determine the best estimate for each Node. To allow time for this additional work, CenturyLink requests a further extension of the filing deadline until February 20, 2015 for the remainder of its submission.
