On June 21, 2012, Safari Communications, Inc. (“Safari”) submitted its Revised Wireless Compliance Plan and on June 29, 2012, submitted its Revised Wireline Compliance Plan outlining the measures it will take to implement the conditions imposed by the Commission in its *Lifeline Reform Order*.¹ Safari hereby withdraws both Compliance Plans. Safari has already surrendered its Maryland ETC designation. For this reason, approval of a Compliance Plan is unnecessary.
