Dear Ms. Dortch:

Puerto Rico Telephone Company, Inc. (“PRT”) hereby files this letter to notify the Commission, pursuant to Section 54.312 of the Commission’s rules,<sup>1</sup> that PRT proposes to modify its Connect America Fund (“CAF”) Phase I Round 2 broadband deployment plan.

PRT accepted 2013 CAF Phase I Round 2 support on August 23, 2013.<sup>2</sup> Along with its acceptance letter, PRT submitted identification of the 40,736 locations where it intended to deploy 4/1 Mbps broadband. Since that filing, PRT has modified its broadband deployment plan to serve previously unidentified unserved locations. Thus, pursuant to Section 54.312 of the Commission’s rules, PRT now submits a list of 230 census blocks not identified at the time of its initial election.<sup>3</sup>

A copy of this letter is being sent to the Bureau, the Administrator, and the Puerto Rico Telecommunications Regulatory Board. There are no tribal areas affected by this deployment plan.


