This letter is submitted pursuant to Section 1.1206(b) of the Commission's rules on behalf of Pandora Radio LLC ("Pandora") to notify you that Steve Bené, General Counsel, and Katie Peters, Director, Government Relations, Pandora Media, Inc., along with David Oxenford, Wilkinson Barker Knauer, LLP (representing Connoisseur Media Licenses, LLC ("Connoisseur"), licensee of KXMZ(FM), Box Elder, SD), and the undersigned met, separately, on February 18, 2015, with Maria Kirby, Legal Advisor to Chairman Wheeler, and with William Lake, Chief, Media Bureau; Thomas Horan, Chief of Staff, Media Bureau; Holly Saurer, Associate Chief, Media Bureau; Peter Doyle, Chief, Audio Division, Media Bureau; Lisa Scanlan, Assistant Chief, Audio Division, Media Bureau; Christine Goepf, Attorney Advisor, Audio Division, Media Bureau; and Jamila Bess Johnson, Attorney Advisor, Industry Analysis Division, Media Bureau.

During the meetings, Pandora discussed its desire to resolve this long-pending proceeding, noting the expiration of the current contract period in June of this year. There was specific discussion of the kinds of information that Pandora could provide the FCC on a regular basis to assess the nationality of Pandora's shareholders, and discussion as to what, if any, structural changes needed to be made to Pandora's organizational documents so as to satisfy the FCC. The applicant also asked for specific guidance as to how to coordinate proposals for resolving these issues, and urged that movement on the application occur as soon as possible.
