Dear Federal Communications Commission,  
I am outraged by Federal Communications Commission Chairman Tom Wheeler's February 4, 2015 proposal to regulate the Internet like a public utility -- a plan that came straight from the desk of Barack Obama.

The federal government has no constitutional authority to regulate the Internet whatsoever – in fact, the idea that government could rightfully regulate the free-flow of information flies in the face of the First Amendment and the speech it protects from government intervention.
