**SUPPLEMENT TO
PLATEAU TELECOMMUNICATIONS, INC.
PETITION FOR WAIVER AND MODIFICATION
OF CERTAIN COMMISSION RULES REGARDING
MOBILITY FUND PHASE I SUPPORT**

Plateau Telecommunications, Inc. (“Plateau”), by its counsel, hereby supplements its Petition for Waiver¹ of various obligations relating to Mobility Fund Phase I (“MFI”) support to provide the Federal Communications Commission (“FCC” or “Commission”) an update on the status of deployment of fourth-generation (“4G”) service.

In its Petition, Plateau reported that it had already completed construction of its wireless network to provide 4G mobile broadband coverage at speeds and latency required by the Commission (“4G Coverage”) to at least 80% of the previously unserved road miles (“Unserved Miles”) in the census tract associated with SAC 498014.² Plateau also reported that it expected to complete construction of its wireless network to provide 4G Coverage to at least 75% of the Unserved Miles in the census tracts associated with SACs 498013, 498017 and 498019 toward

the end of 2014 or soon thereafter, but prior to the consummation of Plateau's proposed assignment of licenses and assets to New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC ("AT&T").³

Plateau hereby reports that it has now completed work, and placed into service sites in two of the three remaining census tracts where Plateau indicated that it would meet or exceed the 75% minimum 4G Coverage public interest obligation. Specifically, Plateau has completed upgrades to sites in the census tracts associated with SACs 498013 and 498019. Consistent with the percentages reported in Exhibit A to Plateau's Petition, Plateau expects that performance tests will demonstrate that Plateau's network provides 4G Coverage to 88% of the Unserved Miles in the census tract associated with SAC 498013 and 4G Coverage to 79% of the Unserved Miles in the census tract associated with SAC 498019.

Plateau needs to complete the upgrade to one site in the census tract associated with SAC 498017 in order to meet the 4G Coverage requirement. Plateau is working on this site to complete the necessary tower modifications, and will further supplement the Petition as appropriate.

Plateau continues to urge the Commission to grant the relief requested in the Petition. As explained therein, Plateau has met its MFI public interest obligations, and the Commission has achieved its broadband deployment goals, in the census tracts associated with SACs 498013, 498014, and 498019. Plateau also continues to anticipate that it soon will meet its public interest obligations, and the Commission will have achieved its broadband deployment goals, in the census tract associated with SAC 498017. There is good cause to grant the relief requested.

Plateau also encourages the Commission to act quickly on the Petition so that Plateau can commence the necessary performance testing to demonstrate coverage. Due to the highly

burdensome and expensive testing methodology contemplated for the performance testing, it would not be prudent or justifiable for Plateau to conduct drive tests to demonstrate coverage absent favorable Commission action on the Petition.
