To whom it may concern,

Recently Shure Incorporated filed a comment in regards to Docket No. 14-166. Part of this comment was a recommendation to limit licensed part 74 users of wireless microphones in the UHF band to a maximum power output of 50mw. This limit may seem sufficient to Shure, however for many of us licensed users in the television and motion picture industries, the limit is not acceptable with the current demand for wireless performance on location. With a shrinking available spectrum, a constantly growing reliance on wireless microphones, and an ever present demand for increased performance and range, a lowering of the power limit on UHF band wireless will be very problematic. I propose keeping the existing 250mw power limit as the best course of action.
