Pursuant to Section 64.606(f) of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 64.606(f), Hancock, Jahn, Lee & Puckett, LLC, d/b/a Communication Access Ability Group ("CAAG"), submits this Notification of Substantive Change, informing the Commission that on, or shortly after, February 1, 2015, CAAG will change its "CAAG VRS" video relay service branding to "Star VRS." CAAG will inform the Commission of the exact date on which the Company's brand name is changed via a supplemental letter filing.

CAAG will concurrently change its unified resource locator ("URL") to starvrs.tv pursuant to Section 64.604(c)(5)(iii)(F), § 47 C.F.R. 64.604(c)(5)(iii)(F). The date on which CAAG's brand name change takes effect, those accessing CAAG VRS' caagvrs.com URL will be automatically redirected to the starvrs.tv URL. CAAG will initiate outreach efforts to inform registered consumers and the public of its change in branding. The company will also work closely with the Fund Administrator to ensure a seamless transition for reporting purposes.
