Dear Ms. Dortch:

Pursuant to the Commission's Order in the above-captioned proceedings (FCC 13-146, released November 1, 2013) (the "Order"), SMS/800, Inc. (the "Company") will assume the role of the neutral SMS administrator from Data Service Management, Inc. ("DSMI") as of March 1, 2015.

As required by the Order, the Company now has in place the new twelve-member Board of Directors comprised of four elected industry representatives, three Bell Operating Company designated seats, four independent directors and the Company's CEO. Further, Company has met all other requirements in connection with assuming the neutral SMS administrator role including restructuring its membership and governance in accordance with the Order, filing and maintaining the Tariff and adhering to the terms and conditions of the administration of the SMS service. Thus, the Company has fulfilled the pre-requisite to assume the role of neutral SMS administrator. The Commission previously determined that, at the time the new board is in place, the Company qualifies to be the neutral SMS administrator under Section 251(e) of the Communications Act and Part 52.12 of the Commission's rules (Order, paragraphs 39-47). In addition, DSMI has notified the Company that it will no longer perform the role of Neutral Administrator as of February 28, 2015.
