On behalf of New Paris Telephone's Quality Cablevision ("Quality Cablevision"), JSI hereby files this letter to notify the Commission that Quality Cablevision has filed a streamlined response in the Commission's Special Access Data Collection web portal.

Initially, Quality Cablevision had identified that it would need to file as a Competitive Provider.¹ However, as Quality Cablevision began to research and gather the data it discovered that it was not a Competitive Provider. As a result, Quality Cablevision is not a Provider, Purchaser, or entity that provides Best Efforts Business Broadband Internet Access Services to 15,000 or more customers or 1,500 or more business broadband customers in areas where the ILEC is subject to price cap regulation. Therefore Quality Cablevision has completed the streamlined response in the Commission's Special Access Data Collection web portal.
