Comcast is blocking Sony's PlayStation 4 and the Roku streaming stick from accessing the online HBO component HBO GO. This is a service myself and millions of other people pay money to get, as HBO is not free.

HBO GO works on the Apple TV streaming box, XBOX 360 and One, and Comcast's own on-demand library (which does not count towards a users monthly data cap with Comcast, whereas viewing HBO GO on anything else does). I do not see a viable reason for Comcast to be denying access for HBO GO, which again is a premium, paid-for service, to arbitrary devices in an effort to make people use only the devices they allow it to be used on. This is a clear violation of Comcast's new Title II status as a common carrier and of net neutrality in general.
