In separate meetings on March 2 and 3, 2015, the undersigned representatives of Pluto, Inc. ("Pluto") met with Commissioner Ajit Pai and Matthew Berry, Chief of Staff to Commissioner Pai; Maria Kirby, Legal Advisor to Chairman Tom Wheeler; Adonis Hoffman, Chief of Staff to Commissioner Mignon Clyburn; Robin Colwell, Chief of Staff to Commissioner Michael O'Rielly; Valery Galasso, Policy Advisor to Commissioner Jessica Rosenworcel; and William T. Lake, Chief, Media Bureau and staff of the Media Bureau, regarding the above referenced proceeding.

The Pluto representatives provided a demonstration of the Pluto TV linear video streaming service. They also discussed the emergence of Internet-based video programming distributors as competitors to legacy multichannel video programming distributors, and described certain points raised in Pluto's comments filed in the above referenced proceeding -- including the importance to online linear video services like Pluto TV of access to high quality content, and the corresponding risk of subjecting new entrants to onerous regulatory burdens.
