**Re: Notice of *Ex Parte* Presentation  
GN Docket No. 13-114; RM-11640**

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On March 4, 2015, Bill Gordon, Vice President of Regulatory Affairs of Gogo Inc. (“Gogo”) and Michele Farquhar, outside counsel to Gogo, had a meeting with Kenneth Moran and Allan Manuel of the Public Safety and Homeland Security Bureau of the FCC regarding the proposed 14 GHz Air-Ground Mobile Broadband Service (“AGMBS”).<sup>1</sup> During the meeting, Gogo expressed its need for additional spectrum capacity and encouraged the FCC to hold an auction for AGMBS spectrum expeditiously.

The parties also discussed Gogo’s ongoing efforts to accommodate any flight safety, national security, and law enforcement concerns of the Executive Branch agencies with respect to the company’s existing air-to-ground service, and Gogo’s willingness to satisfy the conditions that the Federal Bureau of Investigation recently requested to be imposed on any AGMBS licensees.<sup>2</sup> Gogo also explained how in-flight broadband communications enhances flight safety for the passengers and crew members, and described Gogo’s rapid response capability in the event of an emergency. In addition, Gogo reported that close to 50 airlines worldwide have now introduced or have committed to begin in-flight service through terrestrial and/or satellite systems. Indeed, EL AL, one of the most security conscious airlines in the world, recently announced plans to begin offering in-flight Internet service through Ka-band satellite provider ViaSat.
