

The Applicant provides the following information pursuant to Section 63.71 of the Commission's rules:

1. Name and Address of Carrier:

Clearwire Corporation

2. Date of Planned Service Discontinuance, Reduction, or Impairment: The Applicant plans to discontinue its provision of digital voice effective June 16, 2015, or as soon thereafter as the necessary regulatory approval can be obtained. The Applicant understands that this Application will be granted automatically on the 31st day after public notice of its filing, unless the Commission notifies the Applicant to the contrary.

3. Points of Geographic Areas of Service Affected: Clearwire proposes to discontinue its provision of digital voice in Chico, CA, Redding, CA, and Reno/Carson City, NV.

4. Brief Description of Type of Service Affected: Digital voice is a VoIP service that enables customers to place and receive voice telephone calls over the portable wireless Internet connection provided by their Clearwire Expedience service. Features associated with digital voice will also be discontinued, such as directory assistance (411). The 2.5 GHz band spectrum that currently supports Clearwire Expedience will be repurposed for major enhancements to Sprint's 4G LTE Network, requiring Clearwire Expedience to be discontinued.¹ Because Clearwire's provision of digital voice is tied to Clearwire Expedience, digital voice will be discontinued as well.

¹ As a broadband Internet access service, Clearwire Expedience is not subject to the Act's discontinuance procedures.

5. Brief Description of the Dates and Methods of Notice to All Affected Customers: In accordance with Section 63.71(a), on March 20, 2015, Clearwire provided written notice, by first class mail, to its 95 affected subscribers.² Clearwire also provided this same notice to its customers via email on March 16, 2015. Sample copies of the notices provided to customers are attached hereto as Attachment A.
6. Whether the Carrier is Considered Dominant or Non-Dominant with Respect to the Service to be Discontinued, Reduced, or Impaired: Applicant is considered non-dominant with respect to the affected service.



The public convenience and necessity will not be adversely affected by the discontinuance of digital voice. The number of customers affected is limited, and all customers have been given notice affording them ample time to acquire one of the many substitute services that are readily available to them. **IMPORTANT NOTICE REGARDING
DISCONTINUANCE OF DIGITAL VOICE (VOIP) SERVICE**

On June 16, 2015, or as soon thereafter as the necessary regulatory approval can be obtained, Clearwire Corporation ("Clearwire") will no longer provide digital voice (VoIP) service to customers in Chico, CA, Redding, CA, or Reno/Carson City, NV. Digital voice (VoIP) enables you to place and receive voice telephone calls over the Internet connection provided by your Clearwire Expedience service. Features associated with digital voice (VoIP) will also be discontinued, such as directory assistance (411). Our parent company, Sprint, is in the process of implementing major enhancements to the Sprint 4G LTE Network. As a part of the deployment process, Sprint is repurposing the spectrum currently used to support Clearwire Expedience and digital voice (VoIP) in order to support LTE technologies in your area.

We will close your account effective June 16, 2015 so that you will no longer be billed. You may contact us before this date if you would like to cancel your account earlier. Equipment used in conjunction with your Clearwire Expedience or digital voice (VoIP) service does not need to be returned. Should you choose to replace your digital voice (VoIP) service, you will need to do so by June 16, 2015. You may obtain a comparable voice calling service from a variety of other providers operating in your area, including landline, VoIP, and wireless service providers. An Internet search for "voice service providers" in your city should provide you with several alternatives. If you do not take action by June 16, 2015 to migrate your service to another provider, your digital voice (VoIP) account will be cancelled, and you may lose your digital voice (VoIP) phone number after that date.

Clearwire has notified the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC") regarding its proposed discontinuance of service. The FCC will normally authorize this proposed discontinuance of service unless it is shown that customers would be unable to receive service or a reasonable substitute from another carrier or that the public convenience and necessity is otherwise adversely affected. If you wish to object, you should file your comments as soon as possible, but no later than 15 days after the FCC releases public notice of the proposed discontinuance. You may file your comments electronically through the FCC's Electronic Comment Filing System using the docket number established in the FCC's public notice for this proceeding, or you may address them to the Federal Communications Commission, Wireline Competition Bureau, Competition Policy Division, 445 12th Street, SW, Washington, DC 20554, and include in your comments a reference to the § 63.71 Application of Clearwire Corporation. Comments should include specific information about the impact of this proposed discontinuance upon you or your company, including any inability to acquire reasonable substitute service.
