I am respectfully requesting that the FCC take action on the following proceeding:  
Terrestrial Use of the 2473-2495 MHz Band for Low-Power Mobile Broadband Networks –  
IB Docket No. 13-213.

In November 2013, the NPRM was issued for this proceeding. Since then the process has been, in my opinion, manipulated by companies that have a vested financial interest in the failure of Globalstar with regards to this proceeding, namely Gerst Capital and Kerrisdale Capital. There have been endless filings of *ex parte* notices and comments by these companies. In my opinion these filings should be completely disregarded as they represent the financial interests of the filers and not the best interests of the citizens of the United States.

In the interest of full disclosure I would like to state that I have a financial investment in Globalstar. Unlike those that would taint the process with stalling tactics and uninformed opinions, I do not claim to have the technical expertise to make a recommendation to the FCC. Instead, I am respectfully requesting that the FCC take action on this proceeding based upon the factual information that the FCC has gathered and not based upon the endless filings of those who would profit from an FCC rejection of the Globalstar petition.
