Tempo Telecom, LLC One-Time Letter Notification**

Dear Secretary Dortch:

Tempo Telecom, LLC ("Tempo") (FRN: 0022347199) hereby provides this one-time letter notification in accordance with the Commission's newly adopted rules requiring certain long-distance voice service providers to record, retain, and report certain data associated with the completion of long-distance calls to rural areas.¹ Tempo does not qualify as a "covered provider" under the Commission's rules because it does not have more than 100,000 domestic retail subscriber lines, and therefore does not make the initial long-distance call path choice for more than 100,000 domestic retail subscriber lines.²
