Dear Ms. Dortch:

On Wednesday, April 1, I had a conference call with Chris Helzer, Thomas Derenge, and Tom Tran of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau to discuss the Second Progress Report on AT&T Commitments in this proceeding and to answer questions on behalf of the staff. The staff asked for clarification on the statement in the report, “that it may be necessary for some operators to wait until Voice over LTE (VoLTE) roaming is available before operationalizing LTE data roaming”. For CDMA operators, we would be able to support LTE Data Roaming but since voice is handled on the 2G CDMA network, there is no opportunity for AT&T to offer voice roaming until we support VoLTE. The staff also asked about SMS Texting while roaming on LTE data only and at this point it isn’t clear that we’d be able to support SMS while roaming on the LTE data network.
