Dear Ms. Dortch:

In response to an inquiry from FCC staff, Carolina West Wireless, Inc. (“CWW”) hereby provides the following information regarding its relationship with Verizon Wireless:

- In 2011, CWW and Verizon Wireless entered into an agreement whereby CWW leases 700 MHz spectrum from Verizon Wireless in order to serve CWW’s customers within CWW’s service area, and Verizon Wireless enables CWW’s customers to roam onto Verizon Wireless’ network outside CWW’s service area.
- Verizon Wireless is not affiliated with CWW, and Verizon Wireless has no ownership interest in CWW.
- Verizon Wireless has no influence over CWW’s initial long-distance call path selection.
- CWW does not hand-off long-distance calls originating within its service area to Verizon Wireless or any affiliate of Verizon Wireless.
