On April 7, 2015, Kathleen Abernathy, Executive Vice President, External Affairs for Frontier Communications, accompanied by Kathy Grillo, Senior Vice President, Federal Regulatory and Legal Affairs for Verizon, Alan Buzacott, Executive Director, Federal Regulatory Affairs for Verizon, Bryan Tramont of Wilkinson Barker Knauer LLP and the undersigned, met with Daniel Alvarez, Legal Advisor to Chairman Wheeler, and Carol Matthey, Deputy Chief of the Wireline Competition Bureau.
