By this letter, we are advising you of the current status of your above-referenced Petition for exemption from the Federal Communications Commission's (FCC's) closed captioning rules. On February 10, 2014, the Consumer and Governmental Affairs Bureau (the Bureau) invited the public to comment on your Petition.¹ Various consumer groups jointly filed an opposition to your Petition.²

We received written notice from you dated March 12, 2015, withdrawing your Petition.³ Accordingly, we have dismissed your Petition without prejudice as of March 12, 2015. For your convenience, we are enclosing a copy of the Public Notice announcing the withdrawal and dismissal of your Petition.
