ENFORCEMENT BUREAU'S RESPONSE TO MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

1. On March 19, 2015, the Presiding Judge ordered Messrs. Zawila and White to submit evidence by April 7, 2015, that establishes the owners, officers, and any other individuals

who control the operations of Avenal Educational Service, Inc. (Avenal), the permittee of FM station KAAX, and of Central Valley Educational Services, Inc. (Central Valley), the permittee of FM station KYAF (formerly KAJP).¹ On April 3, 2015, counsel for Avenal and Central Valley filed a motion for extension of time to respond to the Presiding Judge's *Order*, FCC 15M-11, until May 4, 2015.² Counsel proposed that any responsive filings be due Monday, May 11, 2015.³

2. The Chief, Enforcement Bureau, by his attorneys, does not oppose this request for an extension. However, the Enforcement Bureau (Bureau) respectfully requests that its responsive pleading be due on May 12, 2015, which provides the Bureau with the same six business days to respond as is currently set forth in *Order*, FCC 15M-11. If Avenal and Central Valley's submission is as comprehensive as Mr. Zawila's (numbering more than 40 pages), the Bureau will appreciate having the additional day.⁴


