Dear Ms. Dortch:

I am a performing artist and worship leader for a local church. In both of my places of occupation, we rely on wireless systems.

I agree with Sennheiser's proposal to reserve two exclusive blocks of UHF for critical mics & ear monitors. There are many musicians and churches that still use wireless mics and ear monitors in the 600 MHz range. This change would cost me personally, as my wireless systems are in the 600 spectrum.

I agree with Sennheiser's proposal for auction winners to compensate wireless mic owners for any equipment that they will not be able to use after spectrum repacking. Considering that there are many people, including myself, who have only recently bought wireless systems in the 600 spectrum, it would be difficult for us to cover those losses of what would then be useless equipment. This change would personally cost me several thousand dollars. Please take this into consideration.
