Dear Ms. Dortch:

On April 14, 2015, I, on behalf of Telcordia Technologies, Inc., d/b/a iconectiv, (“Telcordia”) met with Julie Veach, Ann Stevens, and Sanford Williams of the Wireline Competition Bureau, and Neil Dellar of the Office of the General Counsel. We discussed how to adapt provisions of the Neustar/Warburg trust agreement in light of the differences in ownership structure and the requirement that Telcordia obtain Commission consent with respect to voting trustees. We discussed whether the Qualified Disposition provisions of the Neustar/Warburg trust would be applicable, and the provisions of the Neustar/Warburg trust governing removal of voting trustees by the Board of Directors, given differences in the composition of the respective Boards. We also discussed how the trust should address any future changes in ownership and related issues that might occur during the seven-year term of the contract.
