The Brawley Elementary School District appeals the denial from Universal Service Administrative Company (USAC) in which they denied a requested extension for FRN 2179128. At this time, Brawley Elementary School District requests that the extension be restored for FRN 2179128.

Background:

Brawley Elementary School District received a letter on December 24th, 2014, from USAC. In this letter, USAC references that an attempt had been made for additional information to be supplied to USAC and no response was received.

Mr. Singh the contact at Brawley Elementary School District has no prior knowledge of any requests being sent to him for additional information. He has not been contacted nor have any letters from USAC been received prior to this letter dated 12/24/14. The authorized signer for Brawley Elementary School District is the Superintendent. No contact had been made to Mr. Garcia either. Lastly, the service provider Nexus IS Inc. that has been granted the service from the application process has not been contacted.



The denial of appeal letter contained the following:

- FCC Rules related to the payment of support for discounted services established deadlines for service providers to deliver services/products to the applicant. The FCC provides an extension of this deadline under certain conditions. Those conditions are documented in the Reference area on the USAC website. (See Service Delivery Extensions for more information). Your request did not provide information that satisfied those conditions. Your appeal has not brought forth clear information establishing that those conditions were met but not considered. Therefore, your appeal is denied.

Additional supporting information provided to USAC:

Brawley Elementary School District is in need of funding that has been approved. We request an implementation extension to align with their approved contract expiration date of 9/30/2015. This will give Brawley Elementary School District the opportunity to work with Nexus IS Inc. to have this equipment installed as soon as possible.
