Dear Ms. Dortch:

Purple Communications, Inc. (“Purple”) submits this letter regarding the Request for Clarification (“Request”) filed by Sorenson Communications, Inc. (“Sorenson”) on March 22, 2012.¹ In the Request Sorenson asks for clarification that Section 64.604(c)(5)(iii)(C)(2) ten-digit number and IP address collection and submission requirements are applicable only when the information is provided to a TRS provider. The Request further provides examples of situations in which ten-digit number or IP address information may not be provided to a TRS provider. Sorenson’s subsequent Ex Parte letter provides further examples specific to the CaptionCall IP CTS service.²

Purple supports the Request and Ex Parte filing and intends to operate under the same interpretation of the Section 64.604(c)(5)(iii)(C)(2) rule described in the Request. Purple respectfully requests that if the Commission grants the Request that it apply to all TRS providers.
