Pursuant to Section 1.1206(b) of the FCC's rules, this notice is respectfully submitted to report a meeting between undersigned counsel and economists Coleman Bazelon and Kristin Stenerson for Martha Wright, *et al.* (the "Petitioners"), and Lynne Engledow, Rhonda Lien, Pam Arluk, Douglas Galbi, Don Sussman, Greg Haledjian and Thomas Parisi of the Pricing Policy Division of the Wireline Competition Bureau, and Rebekah Goodheart, Allente' Keels and Carter McMillan of Commissioner Clyburn's office, on April 16, 2015.

During the meeting, the Petitioners discussed the recent submissions in this proceeding by ICS providers regarding ICS reform. The Petitioners presented their views that: (1) the FCC must cap or eliminate Ancillary Fee payments; (2) the tiered structure proposed by the Petitioners will eliminate over-compensatory profits for prisons and large jails; (3) while the FCC has the authority to eliminate kickbacks, it should decide to not eliminate kickbacks so that correctional authorities and ICS providers can allocate excess revenue to cover any ICS costs incurred by the correctional facilities and (4) the FCC to reject the recent request by Global Tel*Link to have the FCC grant blanket exemption from class action lawsuits. No materials were handed out during the meeting.
