Dear Ms. Dortch:

Verizon (FRN: 0003257094) manually submits to the Wireline Competition Bureau a corrective resubmission of its data container in response to the Special Access Data Collection. In the resubmission, Verizon corrected certain data for location ID and adjustment ID records in table II.B.4, Part 1. Specifically:

- Verizon changed to null some location ID records for which it had inadvertently assigned values;
- Verizon converted to null location ID values it initially reported as "0" instead of null; and
- Verizon converted to null adjustment ID values it initially reported as "0" instead of null.

Verizon is submitting two portable 256-bit AES hardware-based data encryption storage devices manufactured by Kingston. The model is the DataTraveler Vault Privacy Edition - DTVP/4GB, Part # 04301-160.A02LF. Each drive is labeled as specified by the FCC's

instructions with Verizon's FRN and a notation to indicate the device that contains the original information and the device that is a copy.

Each of these storage devices contains Highly Confidential information as defined by and subject to Protective Orders in WC Docket No. 05-25 and RM-10593.<sup>1</sup>

- Database container;
- The log file (SPADC.log);
- The "qc log" file (spadc\_proc.log); and
- A new certification
