
Dear Ms. Dortch:

On April 22, 2015, Gregory M. Schmidt, President and Chief Executive Officer of Vox Frontera, Inc., and the undersigned met with Karen Peltz Strauss, Elliot Greenwald, Suzy Rosen Singleton and Caitlin Vogus, of the Consumer and Governmental Affairs Bureau; and Steven Broeckaert, Diana Sokolow and John Kiefer, of the Media Bureau, concerning the above-referenced proceeding.

Mr. Schmidt demonstrated the Caption Sentinel™ product developed by Vox Frontera. Caption Sentinel™ permits television stations and other video programming distributors to monitor captions in video programming streams to assess compliance with Commission standards for accuracy, synchronicity and completeness. Mr. Schmidt demonstrated the records that are produced for each program in a video stream and how Caption Sentinel™ can be used to determine where captioning errors may have occurred in a video distribution path.
